EVENT DESCRIPTION	The Event will be a State Championship Hillclimb, to be conducted at ROB ROY HILLCLIMB, 375 Clintons Road Smiths Gully VIC 3760 (Melway Map Ref 265 A9) on Sunday 19 th May 2024. Over a distance of 670 metres in a single direction. The Event will also include a Come & Try Class for a limited number of entrants.
The manner in which the results will be determined, and prizes awarded	Timing will be electronic and be accurate to 1/100 th of a second. Class winners will be those competitors with the Fastest time for a single run in each class. Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third placings in each class. In addition, a trophy will be awarded for Fastest Time of the Day. Trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the competition.

ROAD REGISTERED VEHICLES without a Motorsport Australia Log Book

The 2023 VHCC Standing Regulations state:-

- Each automobile participating in the VHCC must be the subject of a Motorsport Australia Log Book. However, road registered vehicles with current registration or current club permit may compete for VHCC points without a Log Book if they comply with an appropriate class to be adjudged at each VHCC round by the Clerk of Course with consultation by the Hillclimb Panel Eligibility Officer.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded by email to all Competitors in the week prior to the Event. This advice will also include Further Regulations and other additional specific information on the running of Hillclimb events at Rob Roy.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.
- The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

INTEGRITY

Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
